Hon'ble Sh. Kewal Singh Pathania was born on 12 February 1969 in village Rait, District Kangra, Himachal Pradesh. From his student days, he actively participated in sports and social activities. He completed his Master's degree in Political Science and Bachelor of Law (LL.B.) from Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla.

His political journey began with student politics. From 1987 to 1991, he served as the Campus President of NSUI at Government College Dharamshala, and from 1991 to 1993, he led NSUI as the District President of Kangra. In 2008, he participated in the historic Dandi March. In 2009, he was honored with the **"Best Youth Award"** by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India. He has always had a special inclination toward sports. He captained the Himachal Pradesh Hockey Team and represented the state at the national level five times.

Shr. Kewal Singh Pathania served as a Member of the Board of Directors of HIMUDA. From 2012 to 2017, he was a Member of the Himachal Pradesh Tourism Development Corporation, and in 2012, he also held the responsibility of Vice-Chairman of Himachal Road Transport Corporation. He played an active role for NSUI and the Congress Party in various states including Punjab, Chandigarh, Rajasthan, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, and Goa.

At present, he serves as the MLA from Shahpur Assembly Constituency and assumed the office of Deputy Chief Whip in July 2024. Under his leadership, continuous efforts are being made for holistic development of Shahpur region.

He has encouraged farmers to adopt natural farming practices to enhance their income. Through the Soil Health Card Scheme initiative, he promoted scientific farming and organized awareness camps for Crop Insurance Scheme. He has also made significant efforts toward the construction of Community Health Centre buildings and the installation of essential medical equipment to ensure better healthcare facilities for the public.

His dedication, leadership, and spirit of social service are truly inspiring. The gracious presence of our Hon'ble Chief Guest in today's Annual Prize Distribution Function is a matter of great pride and privilege for us. Once again, we extend our heartfelt welcome and sincere gratitude to him.

Profile of the College:

Government College Shahpur is situated amidst the natural beauty of the Dhauladhar hills. It is located at Chhatri on National Highway 20, approximately 4 km from the Shahpur bus stand. This region serves as a hub for various educational institutions. The establishment of this college in the Shahpur area has enabled hundreds of students, most importantly girls from nearby villages, to access higher education. A total of 15 acres of land is available for the college campus. Shahpur College is committed to fulfilling the academic, intellectual, and cultural requirements of its students.

Government College Shahpur was established by the Government of Himachal Pradesh through the order notification number EDN-A-KHA (16)-10/95-Part III Loose, dated June 28, 2006.

Permanent affiliation was granted to the college by the Registrar's Office of Himachal Pradesh University, as notified in notification number F.N. 1-604/2012-HPU (Acad.) GC MISC, dated February 21, 2017. This affiliation was further extended by the university for the 2021-22 academic year.

The college caters to nearly 800 students by offering programs in Arts, Science, and Commerce. Recently, the institution has been granted approval to introduce Physical Education as a new subject, further expanding its academic offerings.

The college has successfully completed its first cycle of accreditation by NAAC.

The college has been awarded the Institution of Excellence in July 2025
