The welfare of Minorities Day was observed in the college on 20.11.2023 in common room at 1.20 by Equal opportunities Cell with the aim of promoting awareness and understanding of the rights and welfare of minority communities. Ms. Manjinder Kaur provided valuable insights into the concept of minority rights, various constitutional provisions, and welfare schemes aimed at fostering communal harmony.

She began by elucidating the criteria used to define minority communities and emphasized the importance of recognizing and respecting their distinct identities. She delved into the historical and societal reasons behind the need for safeguarding the rights of minority groups, highlighting the importance of inclusivity in a diverse society. The talk shed light on the constitutional provisions in India that protect the rights of minorities, and the role of various commissions in ensuring their effective implementation.

She detailed the various welfare schemes initiated by the government to uplift minority communities.

Emphasizing the need for communal harmony Mrs. Sarita, convener highlighted the role each individual plays in fostering an environment of tolerance, understanding, and unity.
