Certificate Course in Study Skills Concept Note

Background:

In contemporary education systems, there's a growing concern about the lack of effective learning strategies among students, despite achieving high grades. The focus often remains on rote memorization rather than deep understanding and internalization of concepts. Additionally, the pressure of examinations contributes significantly to stress levels among students, impacting their academic performance and overall well-being. In response to these challenges, the college has initiated a Certificate Course in Study Skills aimed at equipping undergraduate students with essential skills necessary for academic success and holistic development.

Objectives:

The primary objectives of the Certificate Course in Study Skills are:

1. To develop essential study skills including attention management, note-taking, reading comprehension, memory enhancement, scheduling, stress management, and examination techniques.
2. To foster a deeper understanding and internalization of learning rather than mere memorization.
3. To equip students with strategies to effectively manage examination stress and enhance overall well-being.

Session Themes with Expected Learning Outcomes

Session 1: Inaugural cum Ice Breaking Session

- Establish rapport and create a comfortable learning environment.
- Introduce participants to each other and build a sense of community.
- Familiarize participants with the course objectives, structure, and expectations.
- Encourage active participation and engagement from all participants.

- Develop critical thinking skills to analyze and evaluate written material.

- Practice strategies for identifying main ideas, supporting details, and author's purpose.
- Develop skills in summarizing and synthesizing information for better understanding.
- Apply comprehension techniques to various types of academic texts.

Session 7: Note-making Strategies

- Understand the purpose and benefits of effective note-making.
- Explore different formats and styles of note-taking (e.g., Cornell method, mind maps).
- Practice organizing information and creating concise, structured notes.
- Develop strategies for reviewing and revising notes to reinforce learning.

Session 8: Memory Enhancement Techniques

- Learn strategies for improving memory retention and recall.
- Explore mnemonic devices and memory aids to facilitate learning.
- Practice techniques for encoding, storing, and retrieving information effectively.
- Apply memory enhancement techniques to academic content and exam preparation.

Session 9: Effective Scheduling/Time Management 1

- Understand the importance of time management and scheduling in academic success.
- Learn how to prioritize tasks and allocate time for studying, assignments, and other commitments.
- Explore different scheduling tools and techniques to create personalized study plans.
- Develop skills in setting realistic goals and managing time efficiently.

Methodology:

The teaching-learning methodology will be interactive and experiential, focusing on active participation and practical application of study skills. Key elements include:

- Interactive workshops through workbook with hands-on activities and group discussions.
- Use of multimedia resources to enhance engagement and understanding.
- Regular self-assessment and reflection to monitor progress and reinforce learning.
- Surprise quizzes to assess comprehension and retention.
- Guidance and feedback from the instructor.

Evaluation Scheme:

- Continuous assessment based on participation, completion of assignments, and performance in surprise quizzes.
- Summative assessment comprising a written test and post-course self-audit.
- Criteria for successful completion include active participation, satisfactory Performance in assessments, and demonstrated improvement in study skills.

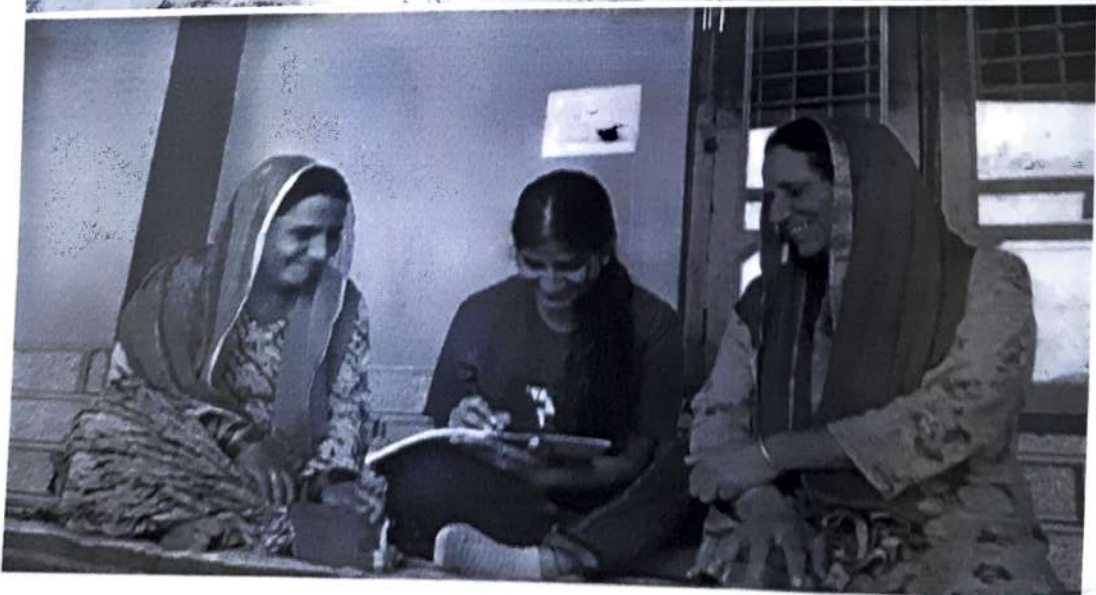
प्रतिक्रिया सारांश:

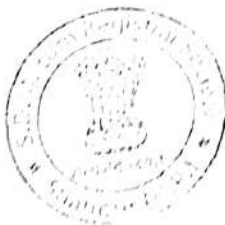
